Topic: Transportation Improvement Program Amendments

Period: April 6, 2009 through April 17, 2009

Comment Period:

The New York Metropolitan Transportation Council (NYMTC) announces a comment period for proposed changes to the NYMTC 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The ten day public comment period **will begin on April 6, 2009 and end on April 17, 2009**. Details on the changes will be posted by the start of the comment period on the NYMTC website at <http://www.nymtc.org/abouttip-down.cfm>.

The proposed changes impact all three of NYMTC's sub-regions: Lower Hudson Valley, New York City, and Long Island. The proposed changes include additional projects proposed for funding through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

Transportation projects funded with Federal monies are required to be on NYMTC's TIP. This comment period gives the public the opportunity to provide feedback to NYMTC on the proposed changes to the NYMTC TIP.

The Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) requests that the New York Metropolitan Transportation Council (NYMTC) undertake a series of Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) amendments to program projects and funds on the TIP for the use of the MTA's allocation of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds. This will require NYMTC to conduct a ten day public review. Because of time constraint, I would ask that the TCC staff begin processing the necessary TIP strips while NYMTC is completing the public review.
