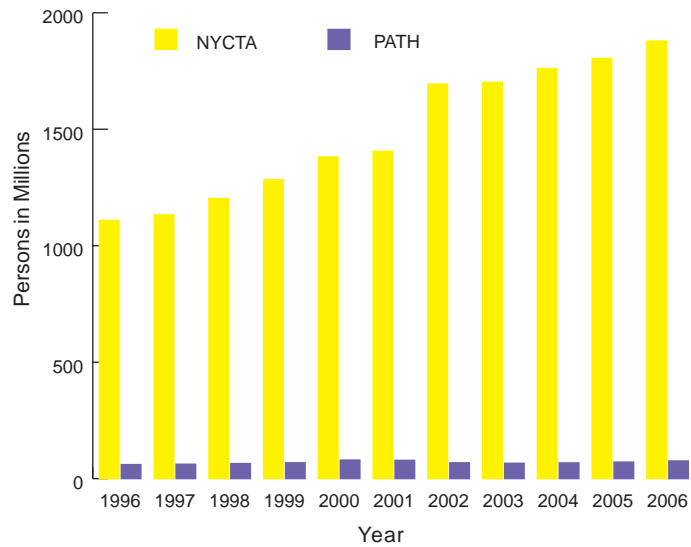
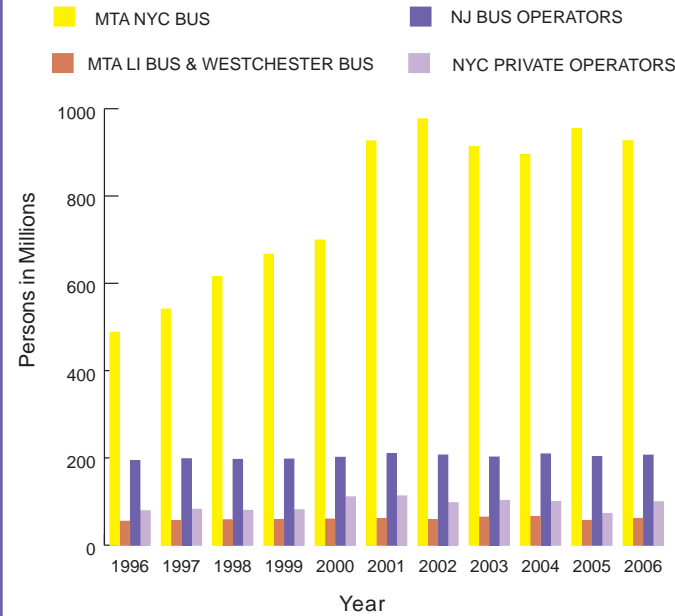

Annual Revenue Passengers Bus Transit



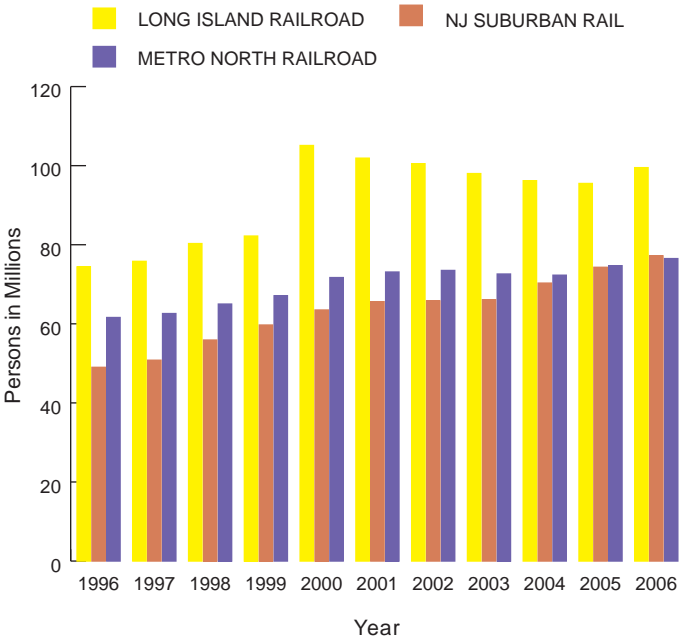

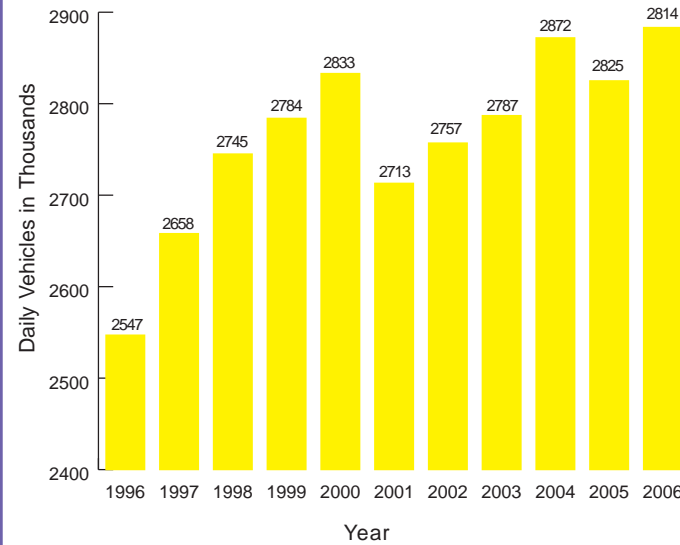
