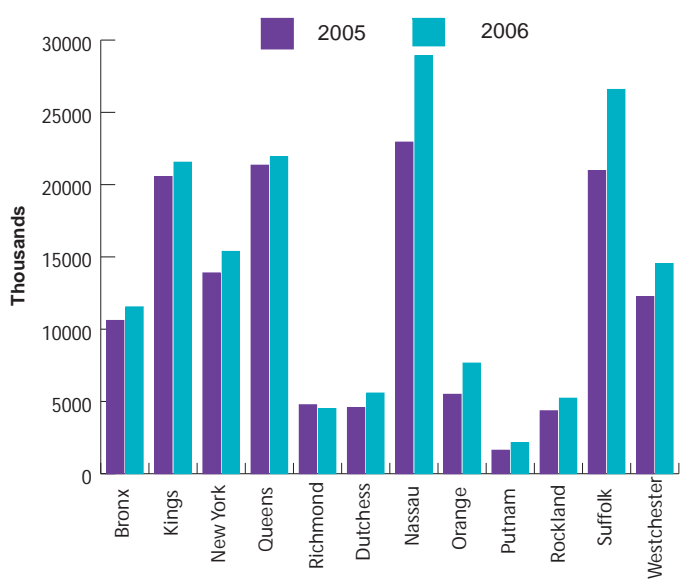
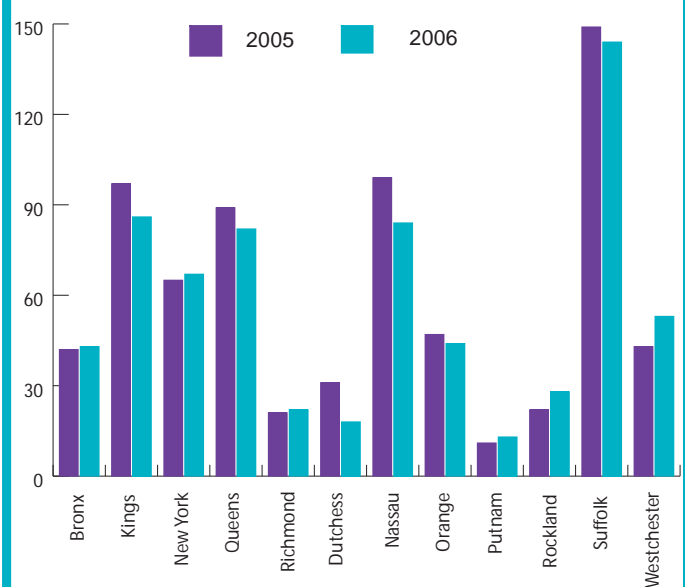


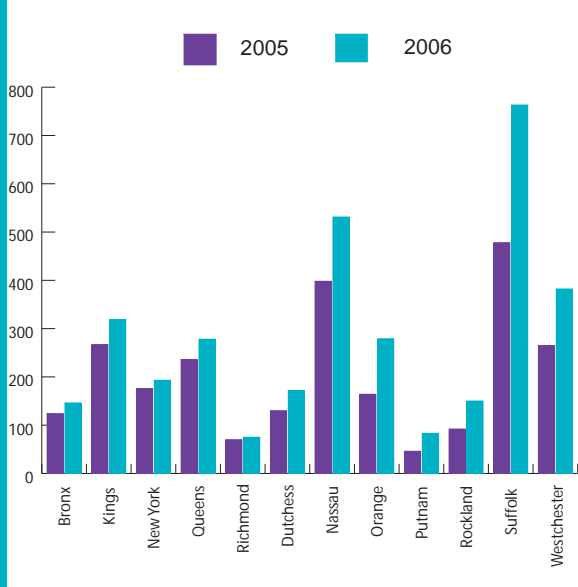
Total Number of Motor Vehicle Crashes 2005-2006 by county

Number of Police Reported Crashes with Alcohol Factor 2005-2006 by county



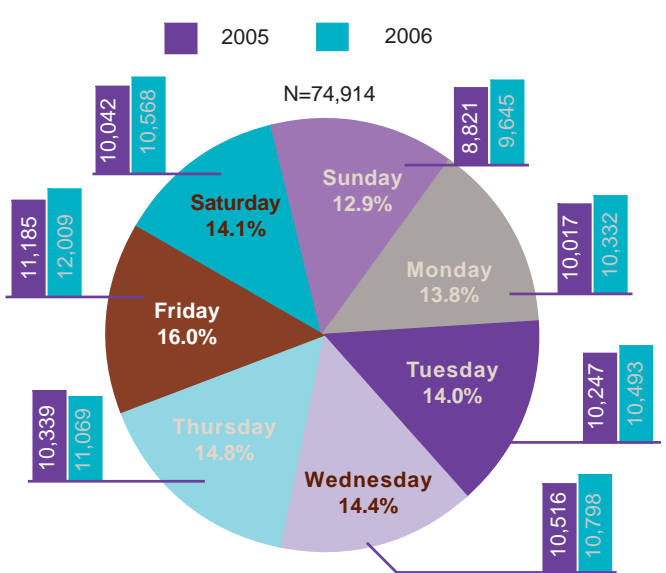

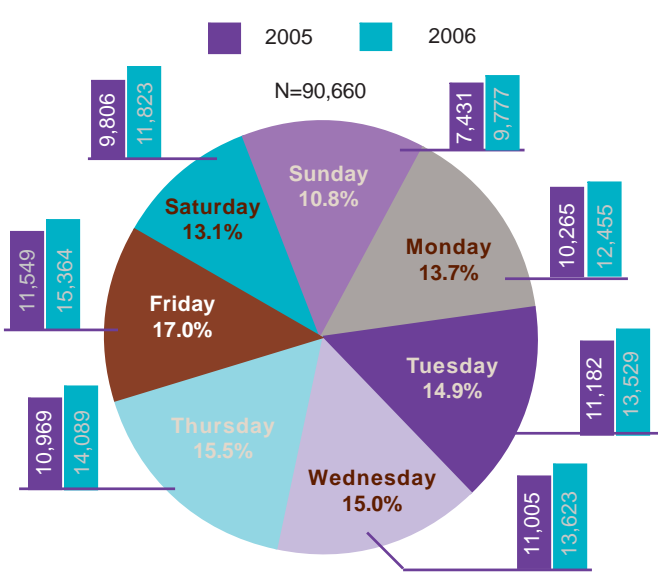

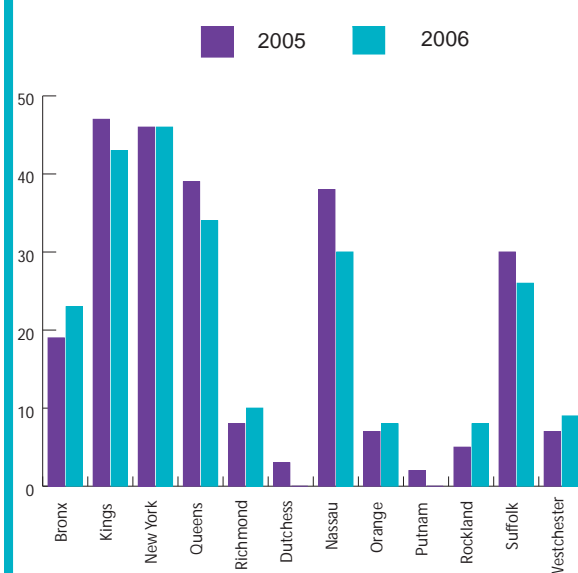
Total Number of Crashes in New York City and Percent Distribution by Day of Week in 2006
