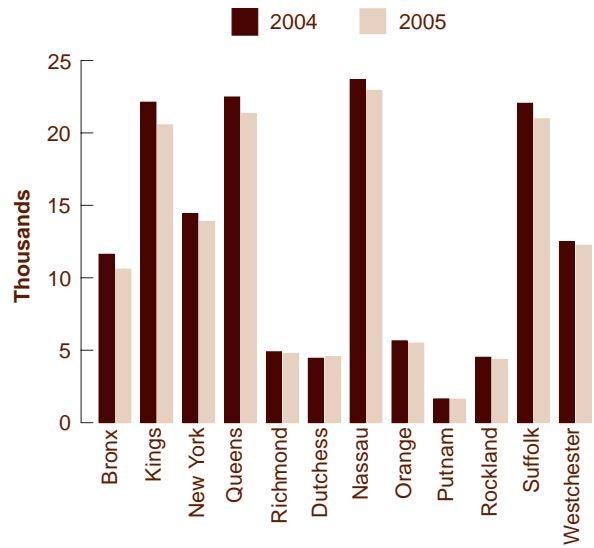
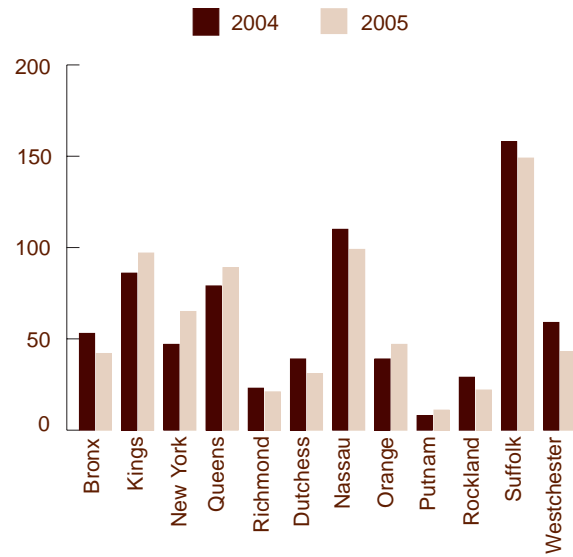


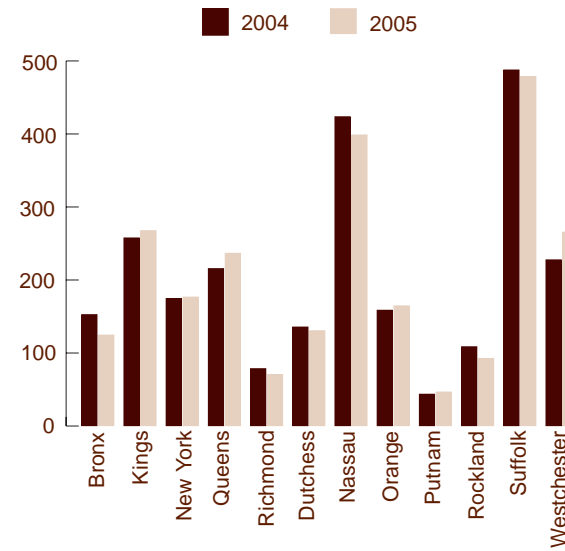
Total Number of Motor Vehicle Crashes 2004-2005



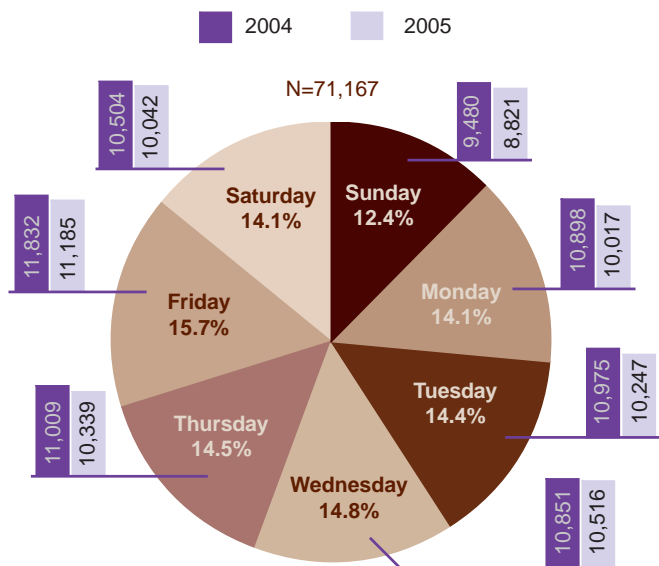
Crashes Resulting in Fatality 2004-2005



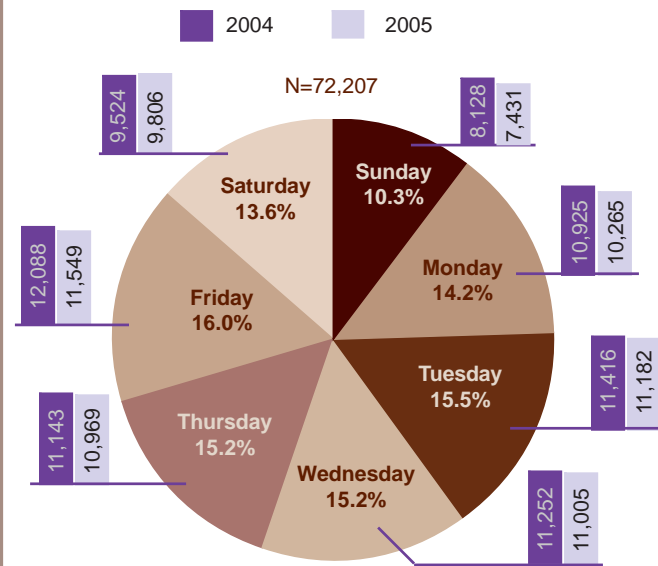
Number of Police Reported Crashes with Alcohol Factor 2004-2005



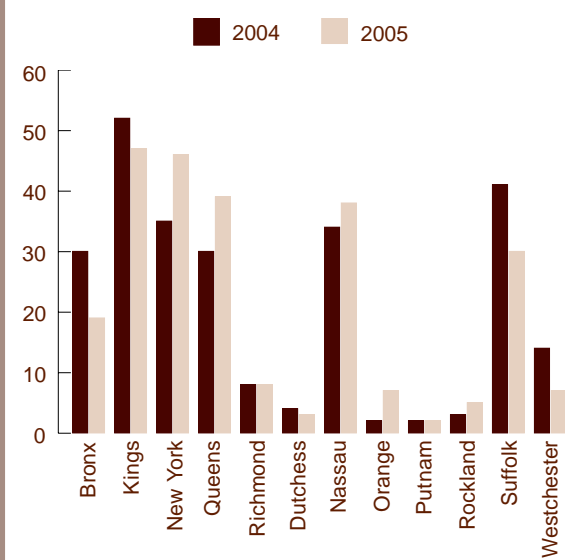
Total Number of Crashes in New York City and Percent by Day of Week in 2005
