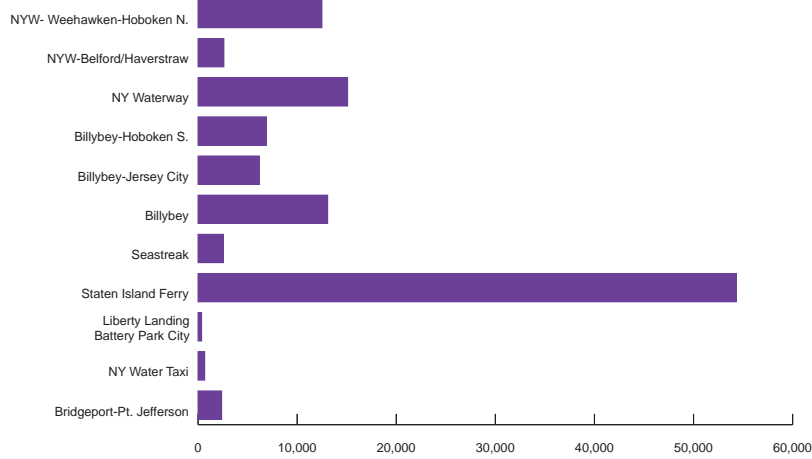


Average Weekday Ferry Ridership by Ferry Operator Q1 2007

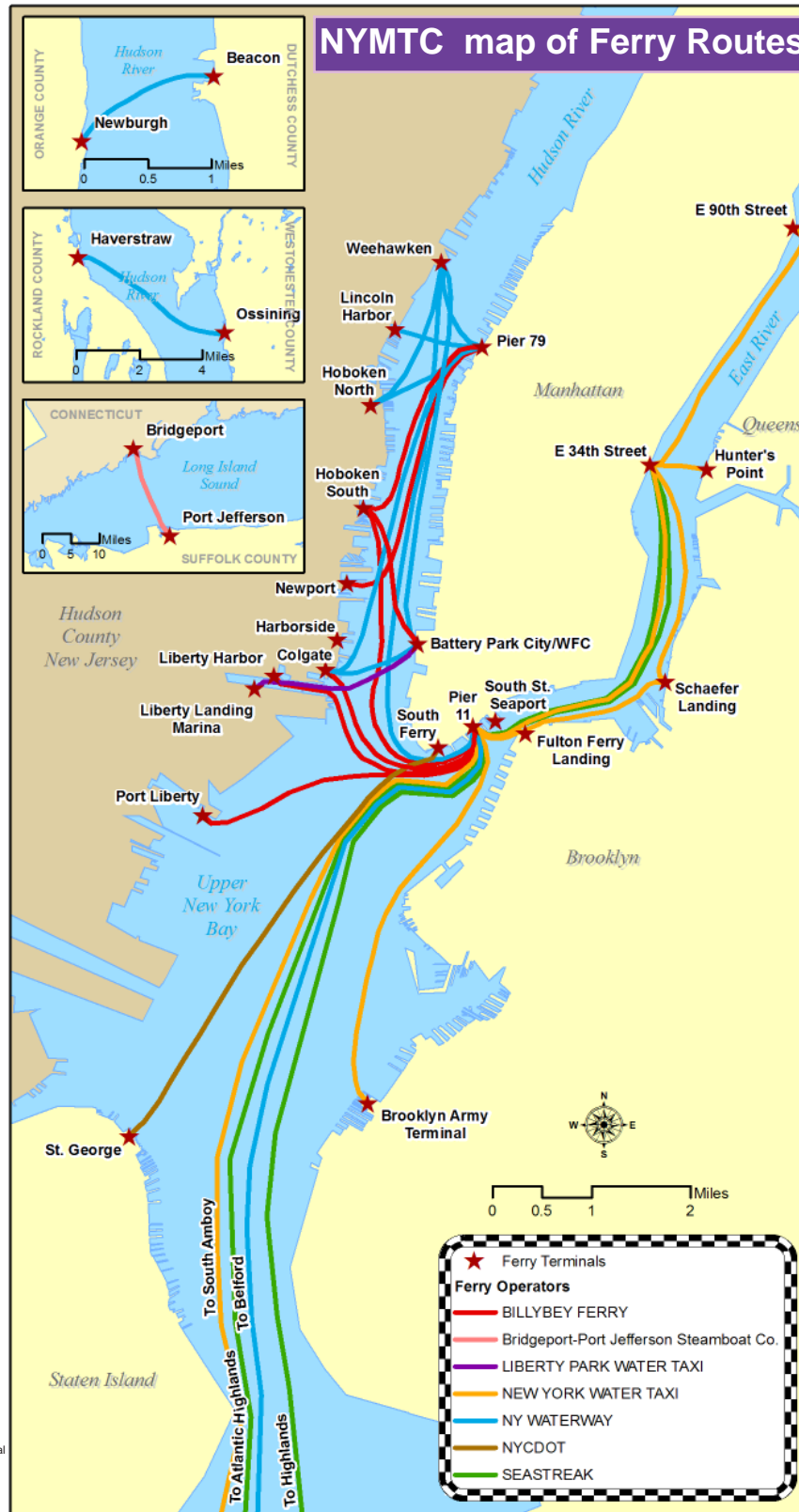

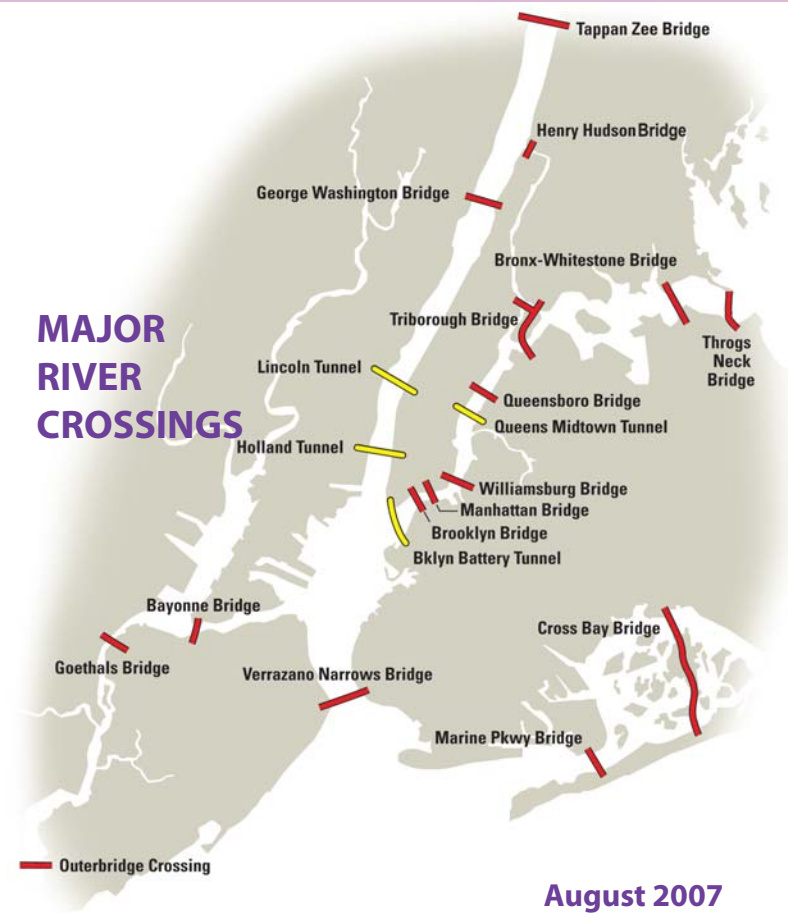

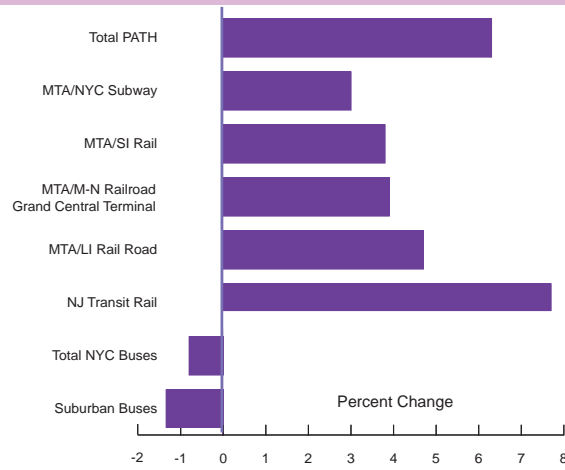

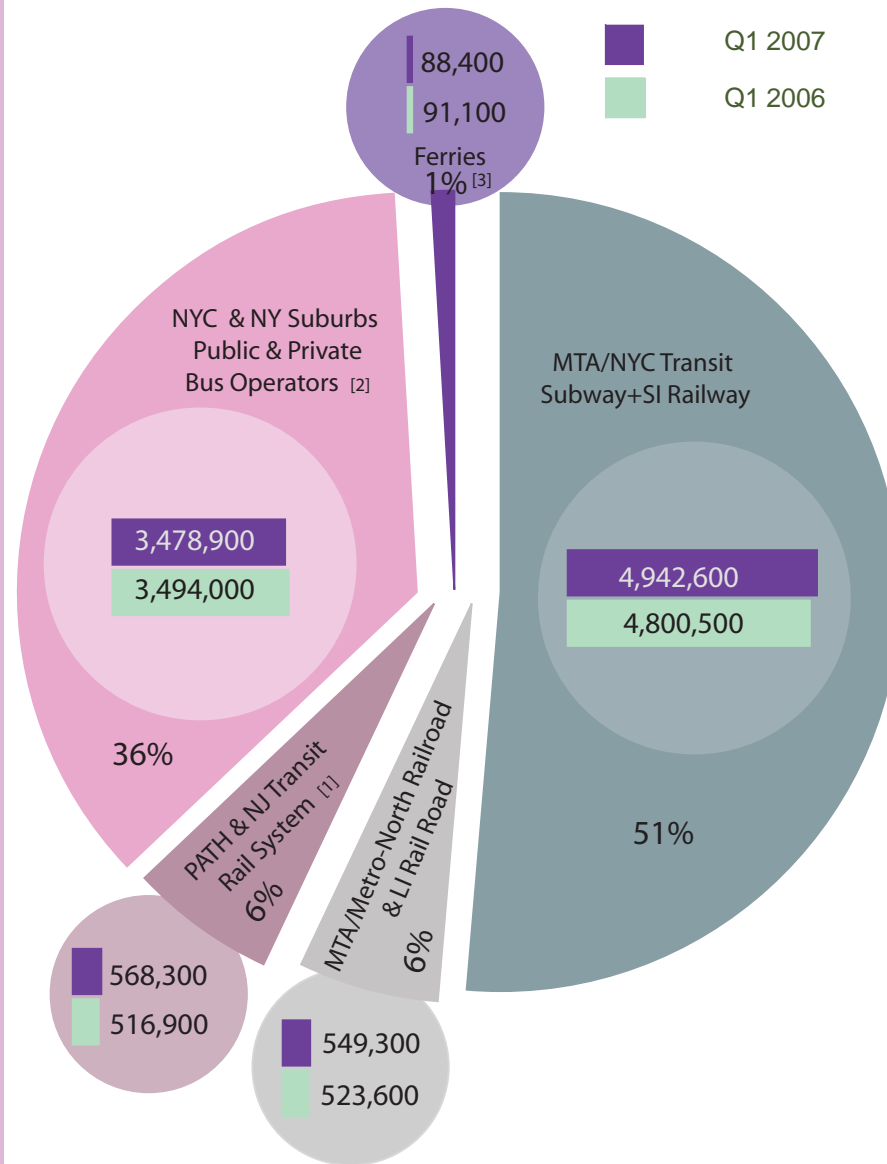

Average Weekday Bus and Rail Ridership by Operator Q1 2006-Q1 2007 Percent Change



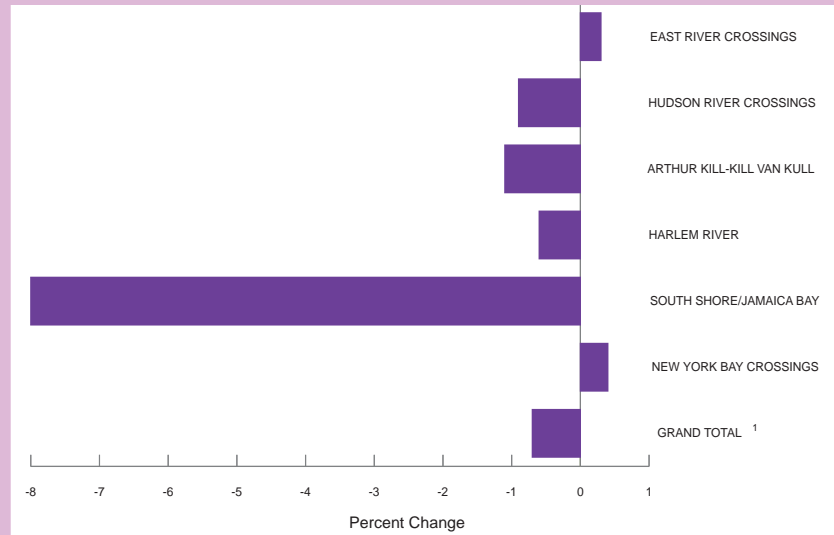
Average Weekday Passengers by Public Transportation Q1 2006 and Q1 2007
