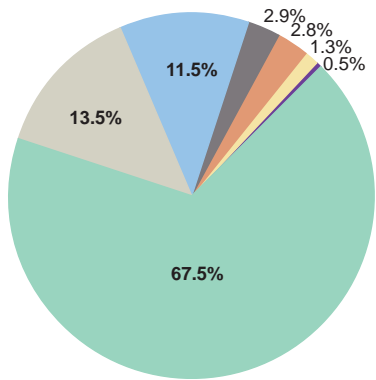


Average Weekday Ferry Ridership

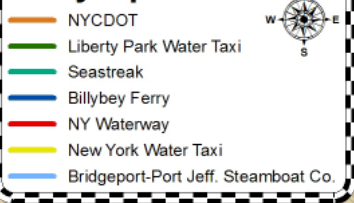

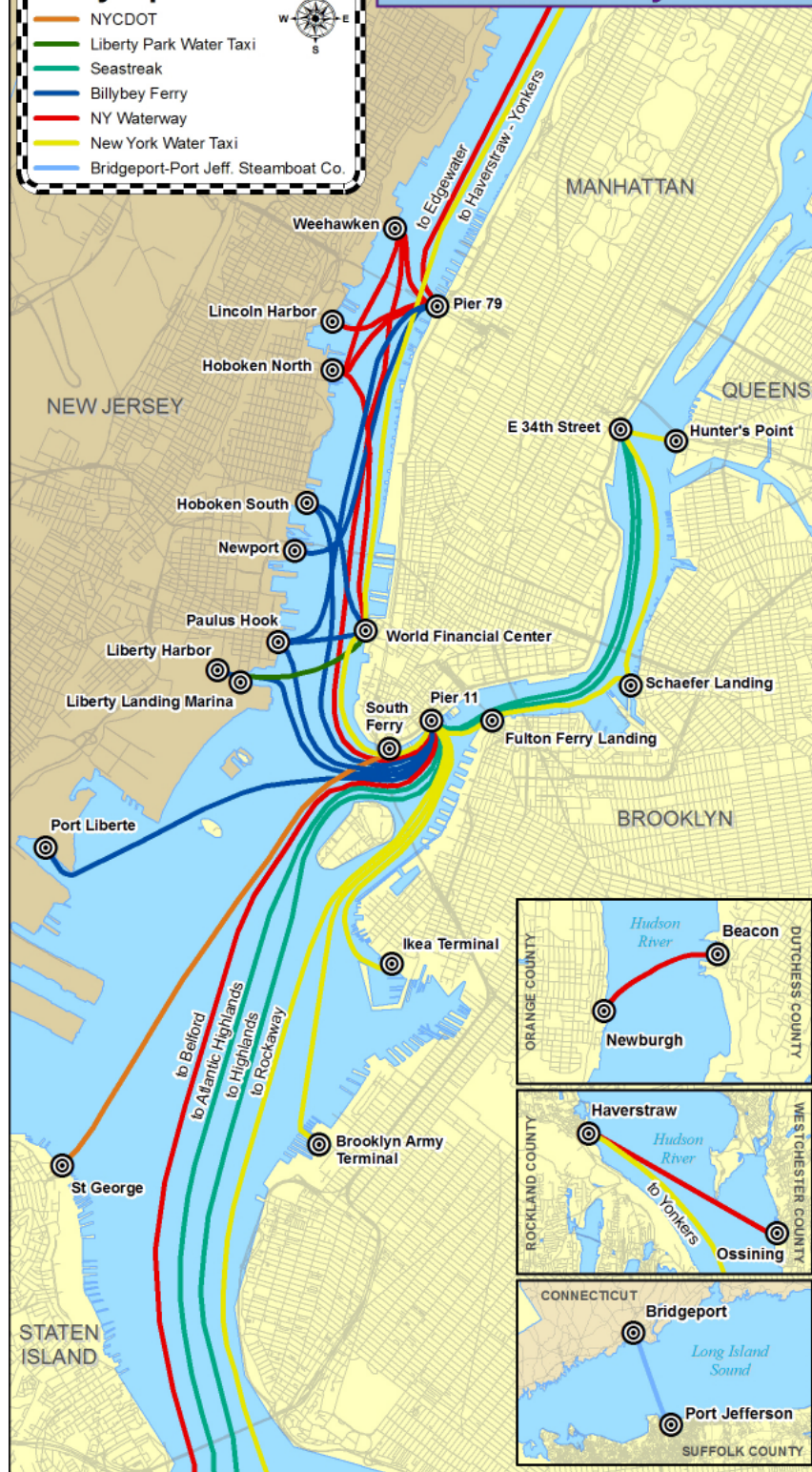

Commuter Ferry Routes



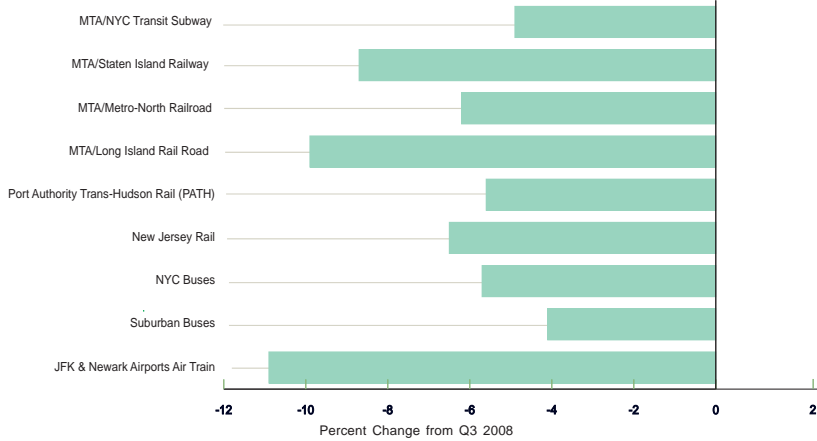

Average Weekday Bus and Rail Ridership by Service Operator Q3-2008 to Q3-2009: Percent Change

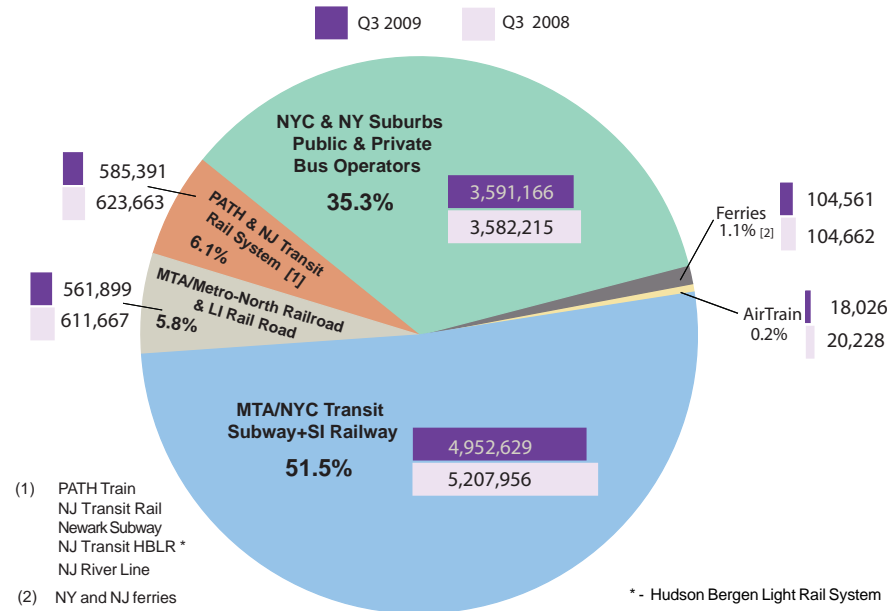

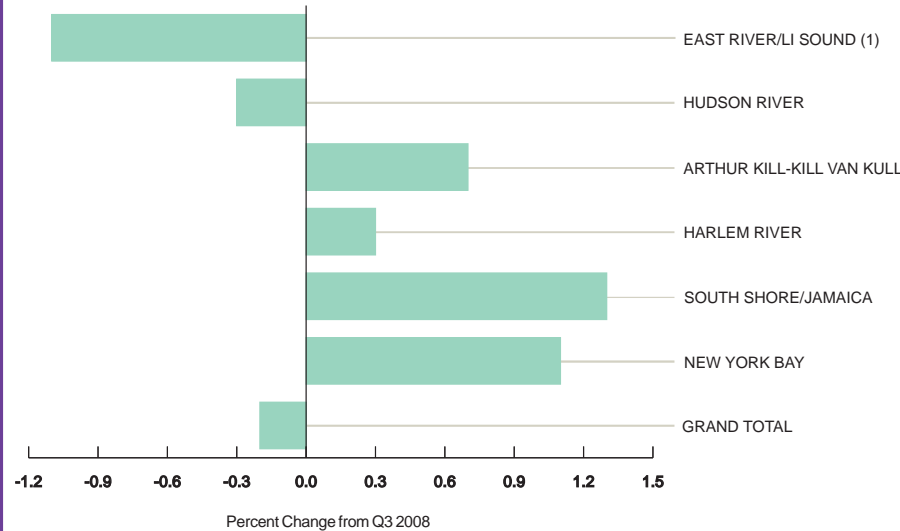
