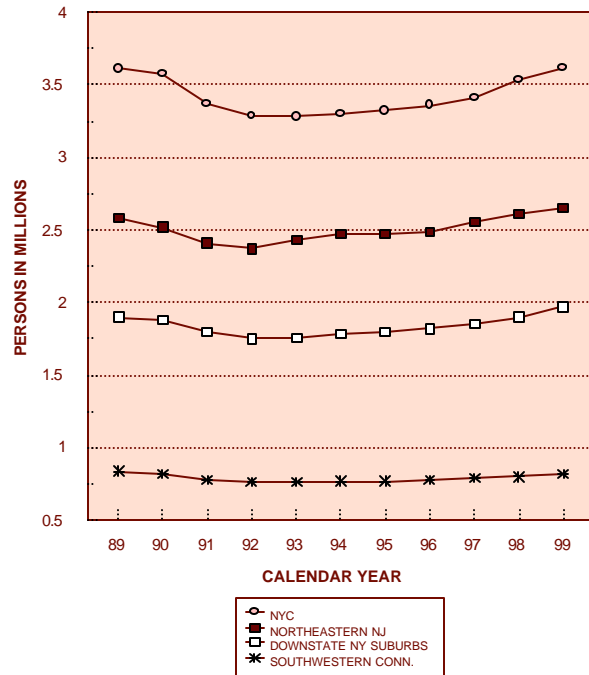

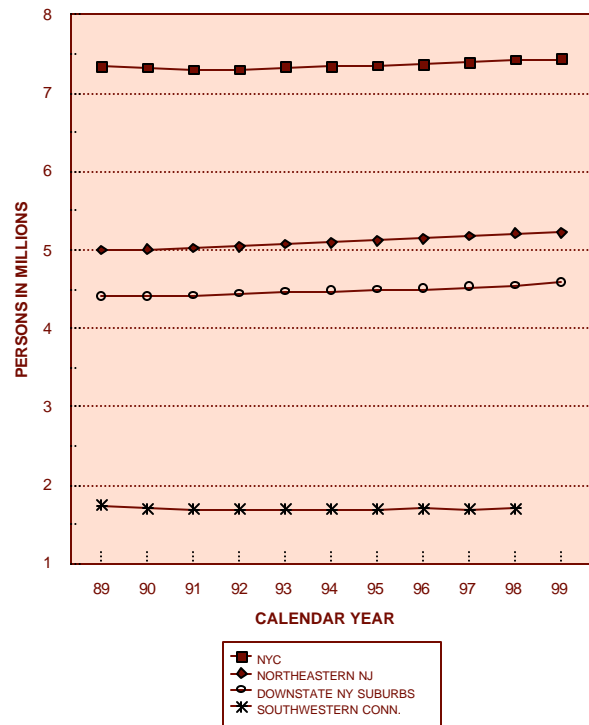

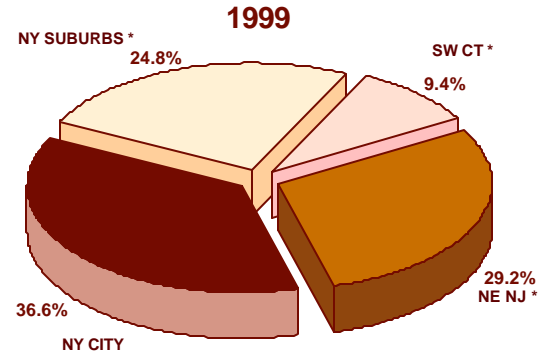
**REGIONAL EMPLOYMENT

RESIDENT POPULATION

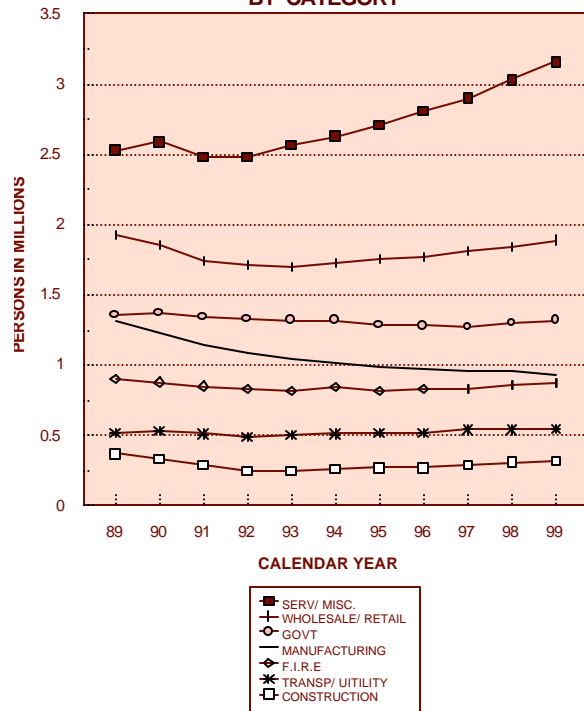


**RESIDENT CIVILIAN LABOR FORCE **
PERCENT OF THE TRI-STATE REGION**

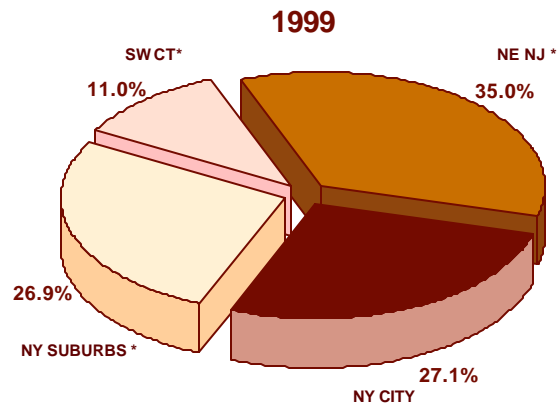

BY CATEGORY**

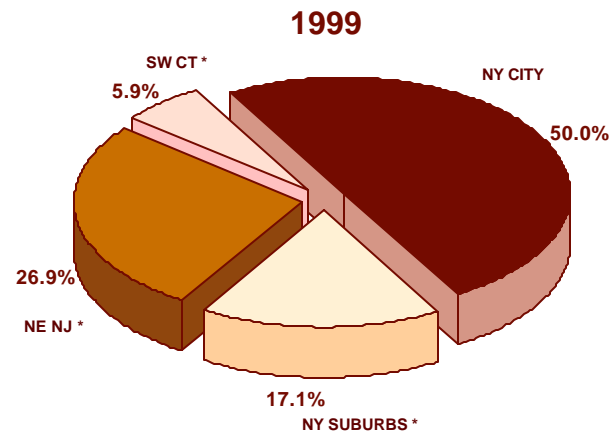


**REGIONAL HOUSING PERMITS
