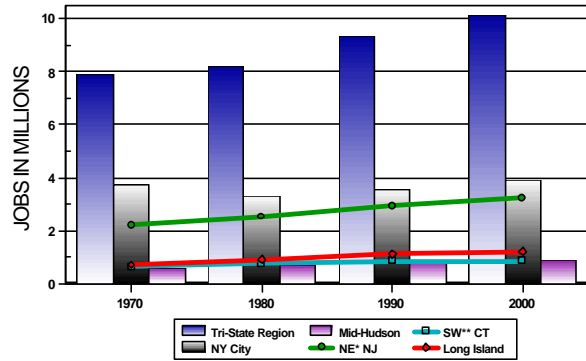
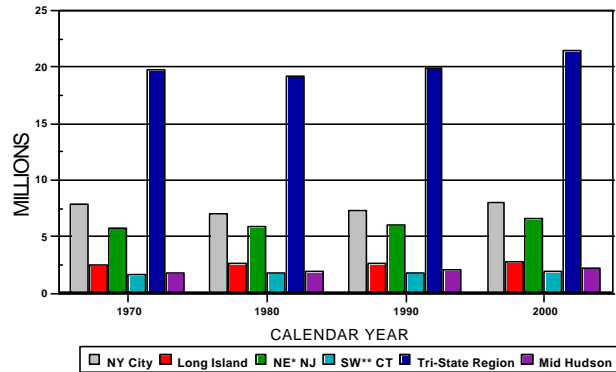

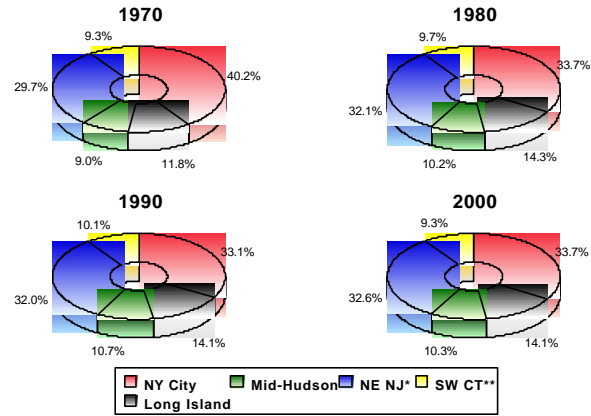

RESIDENT POPULATION



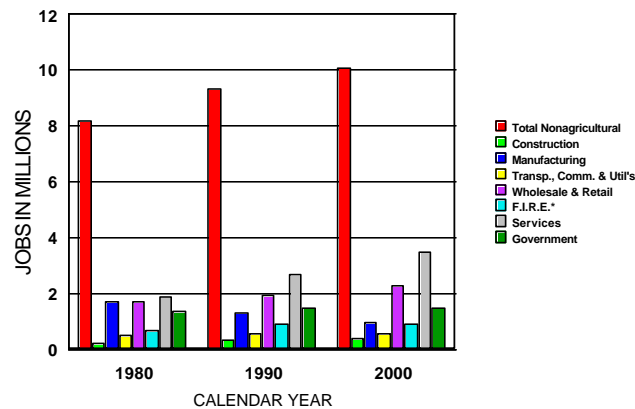

RESIDENT CIVILIAN LABOR FORCE PERCENT OF THE TRI-STATE REGION



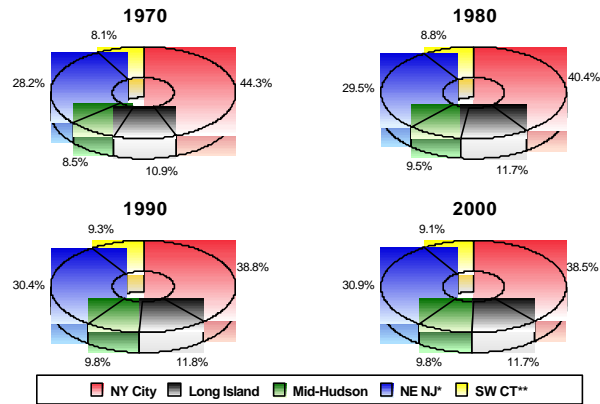

REGIONAL EMPLOYMENT BY CATEGORY



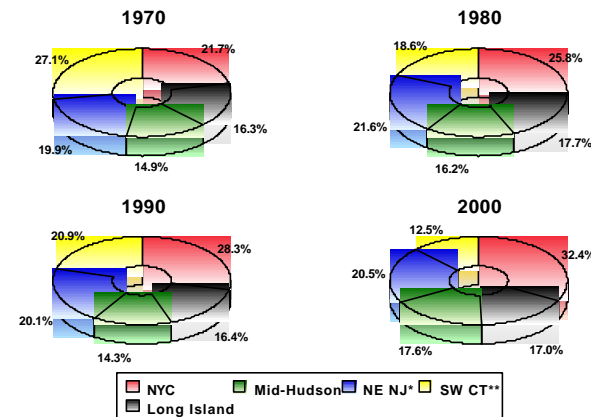
