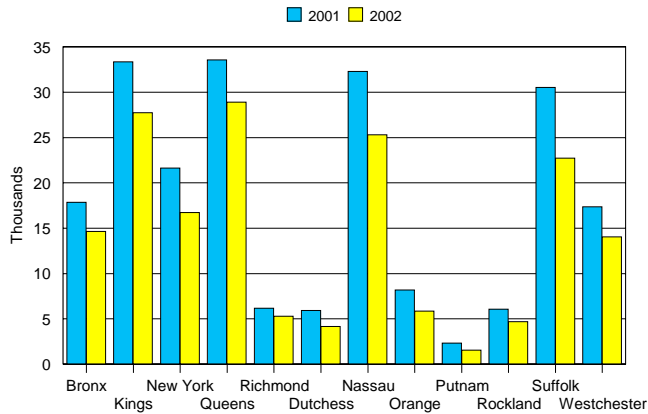
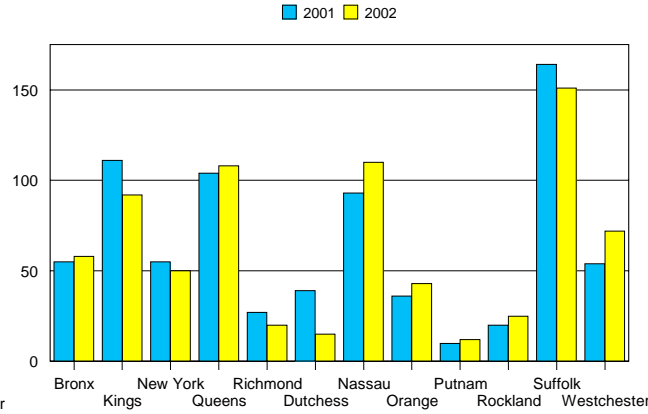


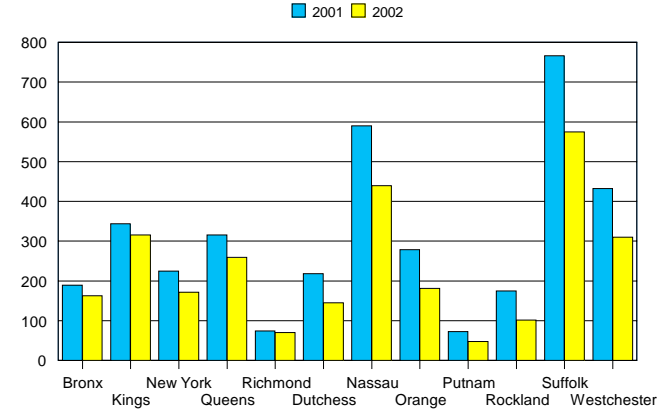
## TOTAL NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES 2001 - 2002



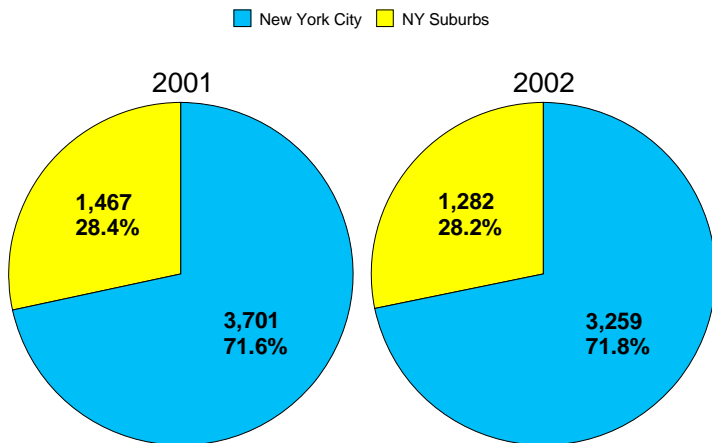
## CRASHES RESULTING IN FATALITY 2001 - 2002



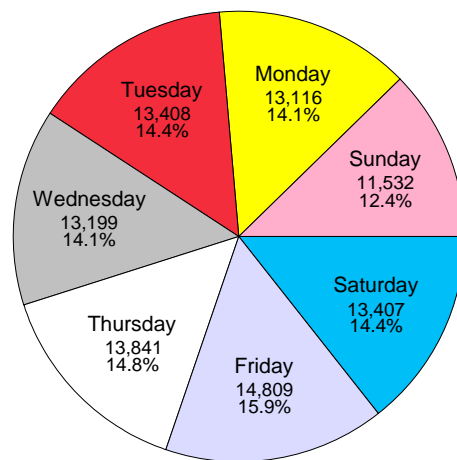
## POLICE REPORTED NUMBER OF CRASHES WITH ALCOHOL FACTOR 2001 - 2002



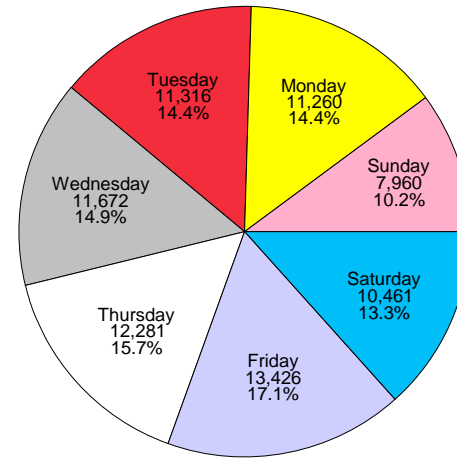
## TOTAL BICYCLISTS KILLED OR INJURED IN VEHICULAR/BICYCLE CRASHES 2001 - 2002
