WHEREAS NYMTC staff has determined that the funds are available to be reprogrammed through these amendments in the SFY 2021-2022 UPWP, and from the SFY 2020-2021 UPWP; and

WHEREAS NYMTC staff has reviewed the proposed revisions and determined that they are consistent with NYMTC's shared vision, goals and objectives as presented in the Federal Fiscal Years 2022-2050 Regional Transportation Plan, entitled *Moving Forward*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that PFAC hereby adopts amendments described above and summarized in the attached table.
