Employment for New Jersey in some categories had to be estimated due to lack of available data.

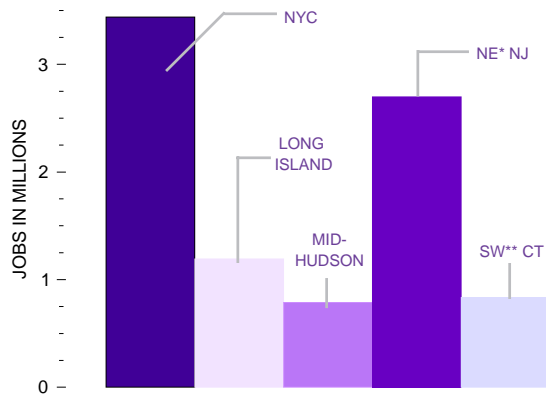

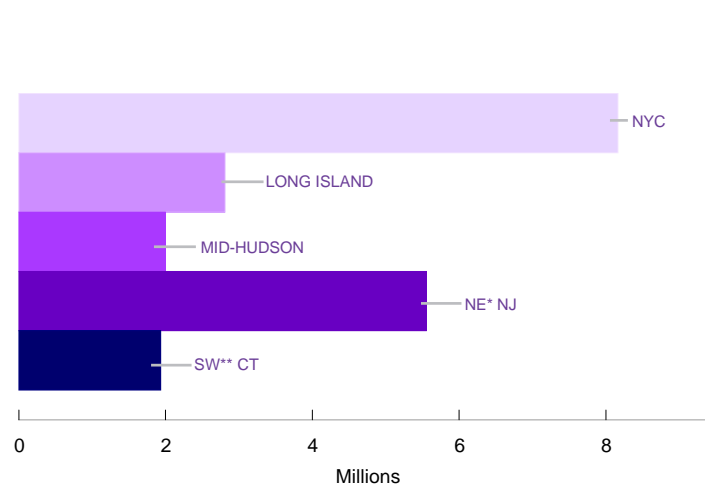

## REGIONAL NON-AGRICULTURAL WAGE & SALARY EMPLOYMENT 2004



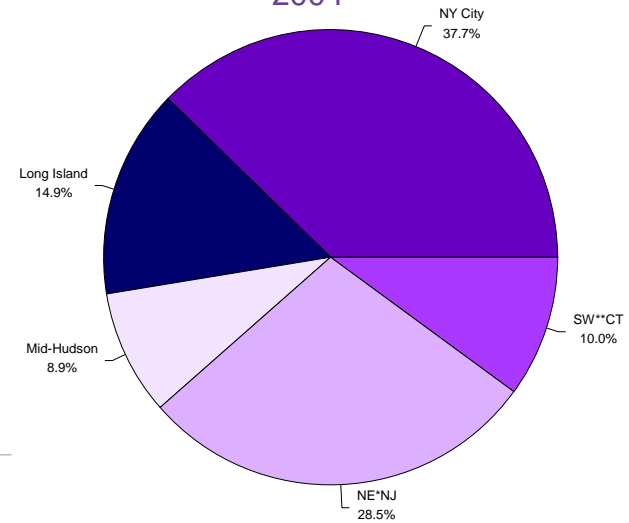

## RESIDENT CIVILIAN LABOR FORCE Percent of the Region 2004



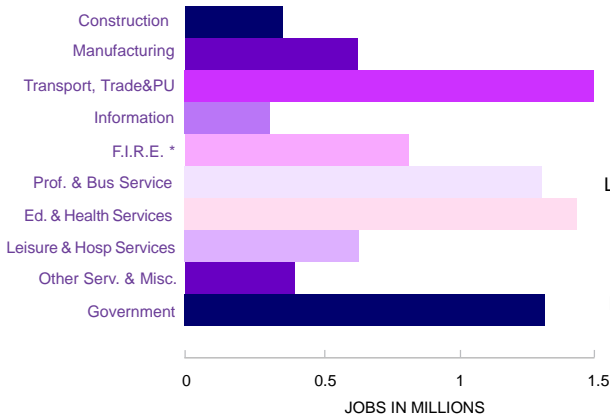

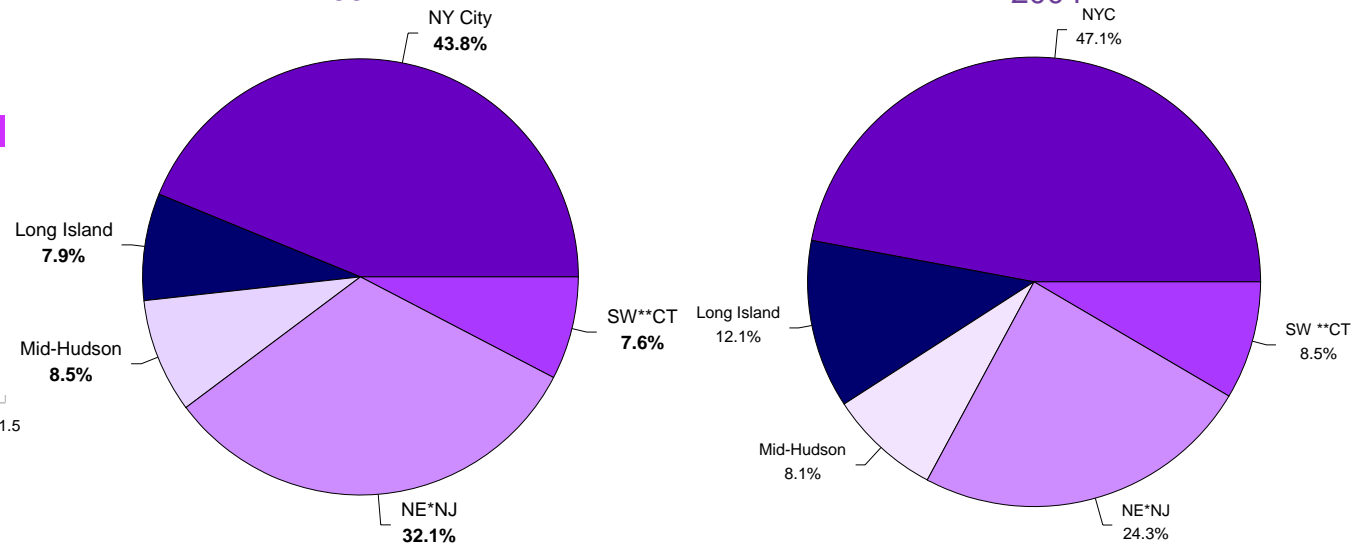

## REGIONAL EMPLOYMENT by Category 2004



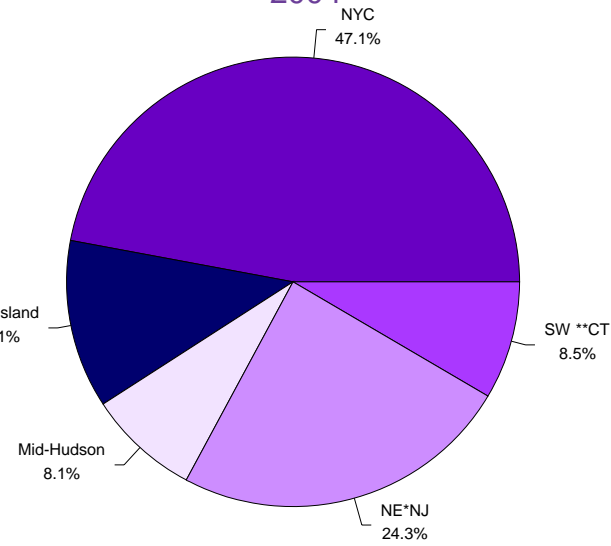
