

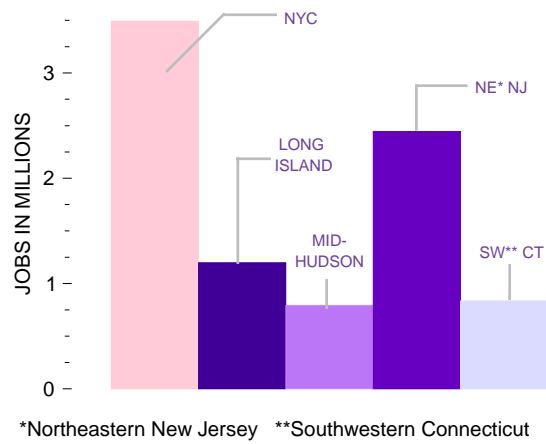

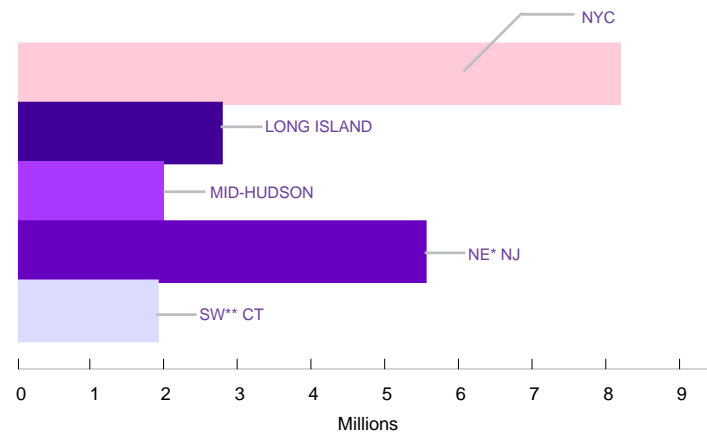

Regional (a) Non-Agricultural Wage & Salary Employment 2005



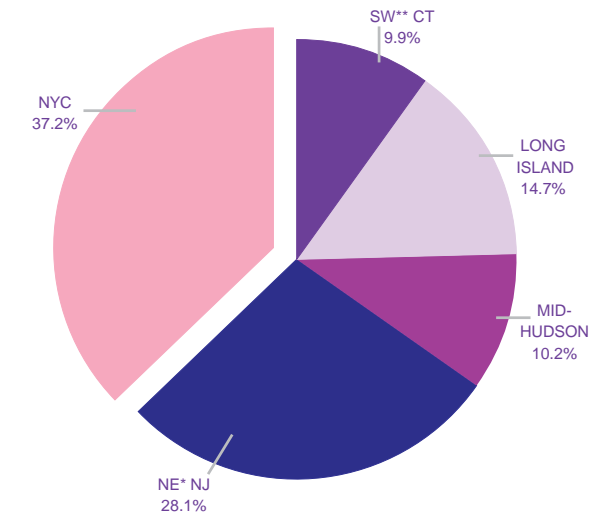

Resident Population in Millions 2005



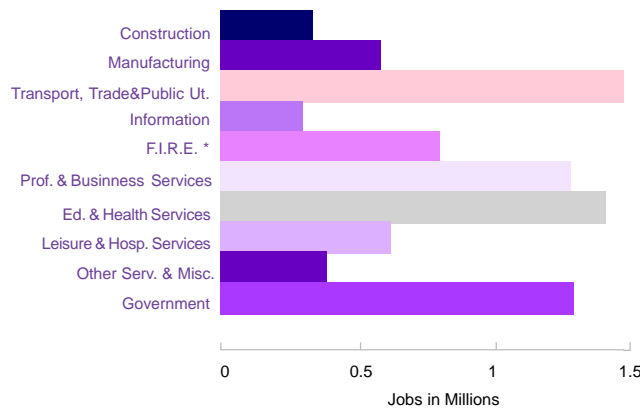

Resident Civilian Labor Force Percent of the Region (a) 2005



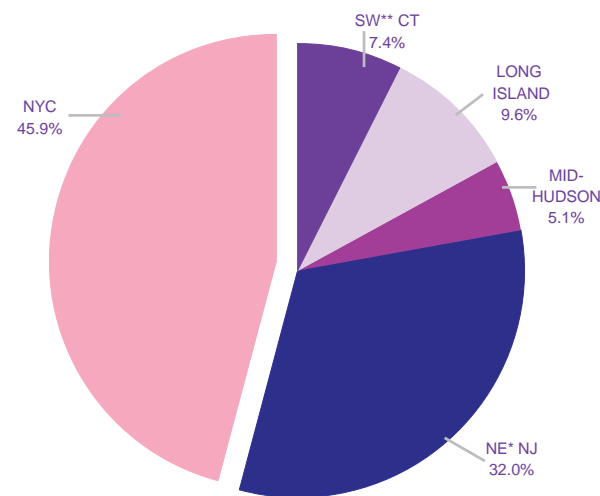

Regional (a) Employment by Category 2005



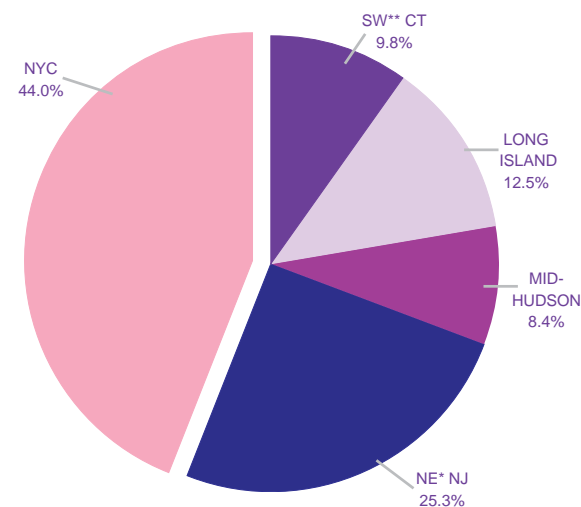

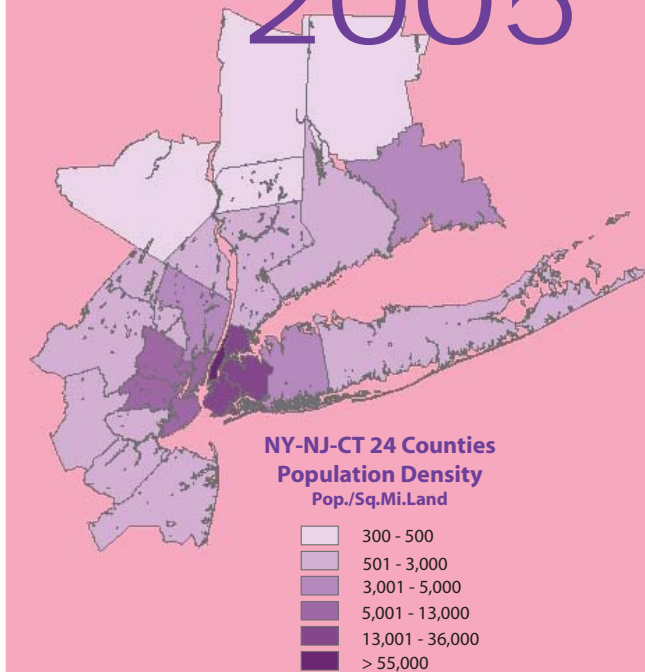
Resident Unemployed Labor Force Percent of the Region (a) 2005
