January 2013 Pulaski Skyway users survey

- Over 5,000 responded
- Majority of Skyway users were going to Hudson County

ROUTE 22 BUS #95 (SEARS PARK & RIDE LOT IN WATCHUNG)



Regular, peak-hour service along the Route 22 Corridor between Watchung and Newark Penn Station serving several intermediate communities via Mountain and Morris Avenues. The new bus line operates exclusively during peak hours.

From Northbound US 1-9

- Use 1-9 Local Lanes
- Take Haynes Avenue Exit
- Proceed on Haynes Avenue over Routes 1-9 to Frelinghuysen Avenue
- Turn right onto Frelinghuysen
- At the third traffic signal turn right onto US-22 ramp
- Stay right and immediately exit onto US 1-9 South
- Make first right onto International Way

From Southbound US 1-9

- Take 1-9 South Local Lanes and exit at International Way

From Route 22 East

- Stay right after Frelinghuysen Avenue exit and take exit onto US 1-9 South
- Make first right onto International Way

From I-78 EB

- Exit 58A 1/9 South
- Continue on 1/9 South towards Airport
- Make right onto International Way
