Ms. Foster said the products were in conformance with the Clean Air Act and the Environmental Protection Agency's transportation conformity rule as well as the State Implementation Plan for air quality.

A motion to adopt Resolution #259, Conformity Determination for the 2005-2030 Regional Transportation Plan and the 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program, As Amended was made by Marc Albrecht, representing the Metropolitan Transportation Authority and seconded by Kevin Olinger, representing the New York City Transportation Coordinating Committee. The resolution unanimously passed.
