3. ADOPT: RESOLUTION #264 – AMENDMENT TO THE 2008-2009 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM TO AMEND NYMTC CENTRAL STAFF PROJECTS

Mr. Stephen Hausch said that the purpose of the resolution was to amend the current central staff portion of the Unified Planning Work Program by moving existing funds to the most immediate projects. No new funds were used.
